NAG has worked with EA and YDRT to prepare for some interactive signs to be put up next to the Nidd and major tributaries Oak Beck and Crimple Beck, in the Harrogate and Knaresborough areas. They concern water quality and what citizens can do to help.

This is part of a national project, and our signs have just arrived!

The 10 signs will be installed soon, and we hope you find them informative, useful and even fun! You just need a smartphone and an open, questioning mind!

When the signs are all up, we'll send out more information about them. The AI - supported system behind the signs should give you a different experience at each of the sites! See if you can find them all!

Remember it is a pilot system, and the information that is available to you will develop in the light of your experience. Let us know how you get on and what you think!
